

New reporting obligations for the RO e-Transport system from 2024

The Government Emergency Ordinance no. 115/2023 (published in the Official Gazette on 15 December 2023) introduces significant changes that affect the **"RO e-Transport" system**, among others.

Until now, the RO e-Transport system was only applied to the road transport of goods with a high tax risk within Romania, with various reporting obligations for entities involved in transactions with such goods and/or in the road transport of such goods.

With the publication of RNV no. 115/2023, the scope of the RO e-Transport system has been extended to include the **obligation to declare the international road transport of goods (regardless of the type of goods)**. As a result, the labelling of shipments and the creation of Unique Transport Codes (UIT) in the RO e-Transport system now applies both to the road transport of goods with a high tax risk within the Romanian territory <u>and to the international road transport of goods</u>.
